Housing

Accommodation	<p>Student residences at Heidelberg University are administered by the <i>Studierendenwerk</i>, an independent organisation providing various services to the student population. Although the number of available rooms is quite limited (only ~15 per cent of all Heidelberg students can be housed in student residences), the <i>International Relations Office</i> cooperates with the <i>Studierendenwerk</i> to secure rooms in student residences for international exchange students coming to Heidelberg.</p> <p>Students usually stay in single rooms sharing kitchen and bathrooms in groups of 2 – 4, or in dormitories with kitchens and bathrooms on each floor. There is also a small number of single apartments available. The residences are located in different parts of the city and very close to public transport. Shopping areas are usually nearby.
