Semester fulfillment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students must have finished at least 2 semesters(Undergraduate)/ 1 semester(post-graduate) or equivalent before application opens * For transferred students, a minimum of one semester’s result from the transferred university should be shown on the official transcript. * Students must finish their degrees at their home universities after the exchange program. (should not finish their last semester at Yonsei)
GPA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2.5 / 4.0 (B average) or above - ECTS (C or above) * For law, 3.0/4.0 or above
Language Proficiency	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - ENGLISH: If you plan to take courses taught in English, <u>TOEFL cBT 213(iBT 79, pBT 550) or IELTS 6.5</u> is required. * For law, TOEFL iBT 86 or above * Native English speakers & non-native speakers studying their degree in English are waived. <hr/> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - KOREAN: If you plan to take courses taught in Korean, <u>KLAT level 4</u>, or an assessment report by a professor is required. * Students must get permission from the professor on the 1st day of class.
