<b>Language Requirements</b>	<p>NUPACE requires exchange students to be proficient in either English OR Japanese. Unless they attend universities where English is the language of instruction, non-native English speakers who wish to participate in the NUPACE English-language curriculum should possess at least an iBT TOEFL score of 79, IELTS overall band score of 6.0, TOEIC score of 780, CEFR level of B2, or CET-6 score of 480.</p> <p>Students intending to take regular university courses instructed in Japanese must possess level one (N1) of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT), or the equivalent.</p>	
<b>Estimated time to deliver acceptance letter</b>	After the Nagoya University screening committee convenes. Vis-à-vis April admission: Late January; vis-à-vis September admission: Early June.	
<b>Transcript Issuance</b>	Despatched to home university approximately one to two months after the completion of the exchange.
